Call to Order: The meeting was called to order by Mayor Felix Callicotte followed by the Pledge of Allegiance.

Call to the Public: Mr. Steve Ahmann provided the Council with an update on the status of the Community Garden. He also provided information on the development of the Birding Trail Grant.

Barbara Reyes requested that the Council consider scheduling a work session to discuss the Clifton House RV Park.

Danny Cervantez extended his thanks to Council members' Mary Beager and Armida Moir for their dedicated service to the town.

Town Clerk, Espie Castaneda presented Council member Moir and Beager with a gift in appreciation for their public service.

Council Reports: Vice-Mayor Luis Montoya reported that CanyonLands Healthcare clinic was scheduled to open on Monday, November 17, 2014. He also reported that the Senior Nutrition Center has been temporarily closed due to water damage to the facility.

Speaking on behalf of the Business Association of Chase Creek Arizona was Ray West. He expressed his thanks and gratitude for the town's support of the Colors of Copper Event.

Barbara Ahmann provided an update on the progress of the Community Calendar. She stated that the Metcalf Elementary School 3rd and 4th grade students had provided the artwork. Council member Ahmann explained that she and Council member - Elect Barbara Reyes had reviewed the submitted artwork and had chosen the winners. An exhibition of the children's artwork is also in the planning stage.

Town Clerk, Espie Castaneda explained that the seating of the new Council which was scheduled to follow this meeting has been postponed due to the absence of Council member-Elect Roy Tyler who was not available due to health issues. The oath of office must be administered and witnessed prior to officially taking office. Additionally, with his absence he would not be able to participate in the seating process of the Mayor and the Vice-Mayor. She explained that the meeting would be rescheduled early next week depending on Council member-Elect Tyler's availability.
