The meeting was called to order by Mayor Felix Callicotte followed by the Pledge of Allegiance.

Town Manager Search: advertisement, salary and application deadline: Town Manager, John Schempf began the discussion with providing members of the council with information on advertising options. Mr. Schempf also suggested that a March 15, 2015 submittal deadline should be included in the advertisement. He recommended that the publications should be posted on the ICMA and the Arizona League of Cities and Town's job postings websites. Additionally, an advertisement should be published in the Copper Era Newspaper.

The council was provided with two similar job specifications each prepared by the Mayor and Mr. Schempf. The issue of disclosing salary information on the job specifications was discussed at length. It was agreed that the salary would be listed as negotiable. Additional verbiage to include was the authorization to allow for a background check. The applicants would be directed to submit their resumes to Mayor Callicotte.

There being no further discussion on the matter, Council member B. Waddell Reyes made a motion to take a short recess before the next discussion. Second to the motion was made by Council member Ray West. Motion carried.

Meeting recessed at approximately 10:00 a.m.

Arizona Department of Transportation: Concept briefing/discussion on U.S. 191 Clifton Traffic Calming Measures: Safford District Engineer, Bill Harmon presented various traffic calming ideas/concepts to address the traffic study recommendations affecting the Town of Clifton. Traffic Calming Measures include Intersection Bulb Outs, Speed Humps and Tables, Rumble Strips, Curb & Sidewalk Improvements, Geometric Adjustments, Intersection Lighting, Rectangular Rapid Flashing Beacons and Speed Feedback Signs. Mr. Harmon explained that prior to considering any of the above mentioned calming measures, any recommendations on specific locations would follow an implementation process to include public involvement, temporary installation of equipment to determine effectiveness prior to constructing any permanent features and final actions would be a post-construction evaluation.

Members of the Council expressed their appreciation to Mr. Harmon for the follow-up and possible solutions to the traffic study results.

Adjournment: Motion to adjourn was made by Council member Roy Tyler. Second to the motion was made by Vice-Mayor Luis Montoya. Motion carried.
